

Continuation of Watab Township  
Annual Board of Appeal and Equalization Hearing  
Monday, April 30, 2018

The Watab Township Board of Appeal and Equalization Hearing was reconvened by Vice-Chairman Gondeck at nine o'clock a.m. on Monday, April 30, 2018 in the Watab Town Hall.

ROLL CALL

Members present included Supervisor Gondeck, Supervisor Johnson, and Supervisor Waytashek. Others present were Clerk Hull, Treasurer O'Keefe, and interim Benton County Assessor Behrenbrinker.

PROPERTY VALUATION REPORT FROM BENTON COUNTY

County Assessor Behrenbrinker provided information and recommendations on the following properties following the County's proposal to revisit the physical appraisal of the following properties as requested:

- Stephen Peka – reduction of \$7,400 in valuation
- Melissa Nemeth – reduction of \$24,600 in valuation
- Kevin Reiter – no change recommended in valuation

Supervisor Waytashek arrived at the meeting.

- Gerald Kostreba – no change recommended in valuation  
(second assessment visit declined by homeowner)
- Ryan Olson – reduction of \$56,800 in valuation
- Lance Bukowski – reduction of \$28,100 in valuation

A motion was made by Supervisor Johnson, seconded by Supervisor Gondeck, and unanimously carried to approve the recommendations as presented. It was noted these property owners maintain the right to appeal to Benton County if the decision by the Township Board is not acceptable to them.
