RESOLUTION 2018-9: SETTING FEES IN WATAB TOWNSHIP

WHEREAS, the Town Board of Watab Township, Benton County, State of Minnesota is authorized by law to collect certain fees; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of Watab Township has adopted Ordinances that require the collection of permit fees; and

WHEREAS, the adopted Watab Ordinances set out that the fees will be established by annual resolution of the Town Board;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Watab Town Board does hereby establish the following fees, costs, and penalties related to the Town of Watab Ordinances:

Driveway Permit Fee:

\$100 per driveway

Board Member Compensation:

\$ 25 per driveway

Right of Entry Permit Fee:

\$ 50 per project

Board Member Compensation:

\$ 25 per project

Land Disturbance Permit Fee:

Single-Family Residential - \$0

Small Non-Residential Construction Site - \$300

Commercial Site - \$2,000

Development over five acres - \$3,750

Town Hall Rental Fee:

\$ 0 for non-profits and government entities

\$ 75 for residents

\$100 for non-residents

\$100 for-profit organizations & businesses

\$ 25 for set-up fee at time other than rental hours

\$100 damage deposit for rentals where no alcohol is served \$250 damage deposit for rentals where alcohol is served

Catering Surcharge Fee:

10% of the catering bill on all town hall rentals

Special Meeting Fee:

When a party requires action by the Town Board outside the regular monthly meeting, reimbursement must be made prior to the meeting to cover the cost of the board members attending at \$75 per board member

Emergency Call Fee:

75% of the cost of the first hour of the call and 100% of any additional hours for all Watab residents receiving emergency services. 100% of the cost for all non-residents of Watab or those not owning property in

Watab.

Gopher Bounty:

\$3.00 per pair of pocket gopher feet
