## APPROVAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA JOINT POWERS AGREEMENT WITH THE TOWNSHIP OF WATAB ON BEHALF OF ITS PROSECUTING ATTORNEY

WHEREAS, the Township of Watab of its Prosecuting Attorney desires to enter into Joint Power
Agreements with the State of Minnesota, Department of Public Safety, and the Bureau o
Criminal Apprehension to use systems and tools available over the State's criminal justice data
communications network for which the Township is eligible. The Joint Powers Agreemen
further provides the Township with the Ability to add, modify, and delete connectivity, systems
and tools over the 5-year life of the agreement and obligates the of Township to pay the costs fo
the network connection.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED** by the Township Board of Watab, Minnesota, as follows:

- 1. Thate the State of Minnesota Joint Powers Agreements by and between the State of Minnesota acting through its Department of Public Safety, Bureau of Criminal Apprehension, and the Township of Watab on behalf of its Prosecuting Attorney, are hereby approved. Copies of the Joint Powers Agreement is attached to this Resolution and made a part of it.
- 2. That the County Attorney, Karl Schmidt or his successor, is designated as the Authorized Representative for the Prosecuting Attorney. The Authorized Representative is also authorized to sign any subsequent amendment or agreement that may be required by the State of Minnesota to Maintain the Township's connection to the systems and tools offered by the state.
- 3. That, Julie Johnson, the Board Chair for the Township of Watab, and Kathy Sauer, the Township Clerk, are authorized to sign the State of Minnesota Joint Powers Agreements.
